I may have developed a descriptive vocabulary

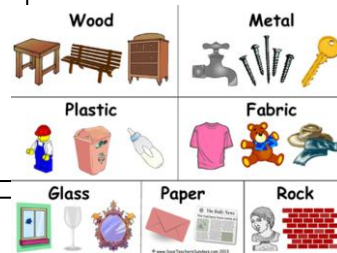
I may be able to talk about differences between materials and changes I see
