What I will learn (Sticky Knowledge)

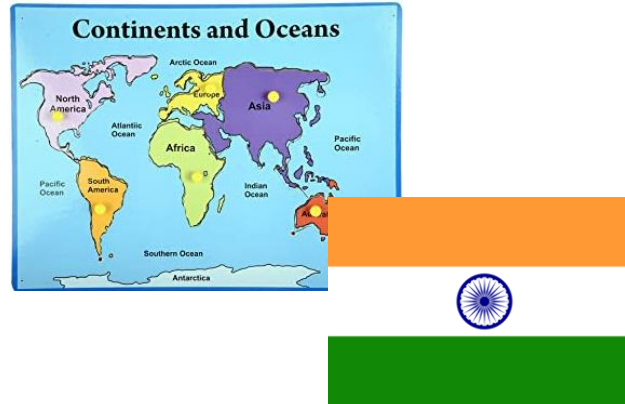
- The name and location of the world's 7 continents.
