The Centre

- The centre has full outdoor land and water-based activities complimented by 70 bed accommodation with catering.
- The site is spread across 4 acres of woodland and has exclusive use of Lower Rivington Reservoir, the largest expanse of water between the Midlands and the Lake District and is often referred to as Lancashire's mini Lake District.



Possible Activities

- A wide range of land and water based activities are offered including:

- Group paddle boarding



Overnight Accommodation

- The centre has 20 en-suite bedrooms under a single roof that sleep a maximum of 70, across three accommodation areas.
- They pride themselves on providing a balanced and nutritious home-cooked food programme served in their dining room.



Groups

- 4 groups of usually a maximum of 10 + member of school staff + Anderton Centre Instructor
- Pupils select 2-3 friends they would like to be with during the day – ensure they with at least 1 friend!
- Rooms – pupils select preferred roommates – depending on rooms allocated by the Centre – pupils with some of their choices.
- Boys and Girls separate rooms/areas of accommodation.
