<p>Country - An area of land that is controlled by its own government</p>	
<p>England - A country in the United Kingdom</p>	
<p>Great Britain - An island that is made up of England, Scotland and Wales</p>	<p>This is a map pointing to Kirkham.</p>
<p>United Kingdom - The UK is officially known as the United Kingdom of Britain and Northern Ireland. It includes England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland</p>	
<p>Town - A thickly settled area that is usually larger than a village but smaller than a city</p>	
<p>City - A large town. Manchester and London are cities</p>	
<p>Capital city - The city is where the government sits. London is the capital city of England and the UK</p>	
<p>Island - A piece of land that is completely surrounded by water</p>	
<p>Sea - A large area of salty water that is part of an ocean</p>	
<p>Monarch - A person who reigns over a kingdom or empire</p>
