Cooking & Nutrition - Making Chocolate

Key Vocabulary

Chocolate is made from cocoa beans.
Cocoa beans grow in hot countries near the equator, such as Ghana and Ivory Coast.

When heated, chocolate melts and becomes a liquid.

When cooled, chocolate sets and becomes solid again.

Ingredient	One of the foods or items used to make a dish or product.
Recipe	A set of instructions that tells you how to make something.
Melt	To change from a solid into a liquid by heating.
Solid	A material that keeps its shape and is not a liquid or gas.
Liquid	A substance that can flow and take the shape of its container.
Mix	To combine ingredients together.
Stir	To move ingredients around with a spoon or other tool to combine them.
Combine	To put two or more things together.
Pour	To make a liquid flow from one container into another.
Mould	A shaped container used to form something into a particular shape.
Temper	To carefully heat and cool chocolate so it becomes smooth, shiny, and crisp.
Decoration	Something added to make food look more attractive.
Taste	The flavour of food, such as sweet, salty, sour, or bitter.
Texture	How food feels when you touch it or eat it, such as smooth, crunchy, or creamy.
Hygiene	Keeping hands, equipment, and food clean and safe.
Safety	Following rules to prevent accidents or injuries.
Evaluate	To think about how well something turned out and how it could be improved.
Equipment	The tools and items used to help make or prepare something.
