



## **Robin's Looking Forward- Summer 2026- Year 1 / 2**

I hope you all had a lovely Easter break.

**English:** In our English lessons this term we will be reading one of my favourite stories 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. We will be using this story to innovate and create new ideas of our own. We will also be doing some poetry writing!

**Guided Reading/ Phonics:**

Reading workshop will take place every day. The children will take part in a guided reading session once a week, plus other activities such as; handwriting, reading comprehension, punctuation games, 1:1 reading to an adult once a week, sentence structure games and spelling games. Phonics will take place every day, the children are expected to practise phonics patterns at home and may receive spellings when required. Please ensure reading books and records are in every day.

**Maths:**

The children will be continuing to enhance their numerical knowledge. Our next focus is fractions, position and direction, learning to tell the time and statistics. We will use practical and pictorial representations in arithmetic. We will continue to develop mathematical ideas and methods to solve practical problems for addition, subtraction, division, and multiplication. The children will start each lesson by completing quick fire questions using all four operations.

**Topic: All other areas of the curriculum will be taught through our termly topic**

In History, our focus will be on Lytham and changes in our local area. In Geography, we will be studying our school and our local area. In Art, we will be drawing and collaging. In DT, we will be creating a structure. In Music, we will be experimenting and combining sounds. In Science, we will be exploring plants, living things and their habitats. During our computing lessons, we will continue to talk about internet safety and digital music. In RE this term, our focus is learning about Holy buildings and the Bible.

**PE**

In PE this term we will be developing our skills in Athletics and Gymnastics. PE lessons will take place on a Tuesday and a Friday.

**Homework**

Homework will be given every two weeks on a Friday. The children will have 2 weeks to complete their homework. The homework will support what they have been learning in class and they are expected to complete it independently where they can, however support and encouragement may be given.

**Reading books/ Library**

Please encourage your child to read on a regular basis. Throughout the term it is important that your child also reads a selection of books at home. Other books, as well as school reading books can be recorded in their reading records too. There is also an additional book box 'Miss Park's books for bedtime' in class the children are welcome to use. The books will be changed when both books have been read (please encourage your child to re-read the books and develop their comprehension skills by asking questions about the text) with a comment, this will be on a Tuesday and Friday. All the children will have the opportunity to visit the school library on a Monday. If your child wishes to change their school library book please ensure it is returned to school.
