

Robins Looking Forward at Autumn Term 2026

English

This term we will be exploring multicultural texts and stories. The children will have the chance to write their own character and setting descriptions, as well as a recount and some poetry. They will then be looking at texts with a moral or a dilemma. We will be looking at story sequencing and will then write our own alternate ending to a story. The children will finish the term by looking at instructions and will have the opportunity to write their own set.

The children will receive spelling sessions each week to learn and revise key spelling strategies. The children will be investigating, collecting and classifying different spelling patterns.

Each week the children will take part in a reading comprehension and guided reading session. During these sessions they will take part in other activities such as handwriting, grammar tasks and punctuation games.



Please encourage your child to read on a **regular basis**. It is important to make sure that your child reads a selection of books at home. Other books, as well as school reading books can be recorded in their reading records too. The children will change their books on Mondays and Thursdays.

Please make sure your child has their reading book and record in school **every day**.



Maths

To begin our numeracy programme for the year, we will be learning about:

Number skills of addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, measurement (length and mass), time, 2D and 3D Shapes.

Geography/History

In History, we will be looking at an event beyond living memory that is significant globally. Our topic will be The Great Fire of London.

In Geography, we will be learning about the countries in the UK, focusing on England and Scotland.

PSHE

In PSHE we are going to look at Health and Wellbeing with a focus on healthy relationships.

Art & DT

In Art, we will be looking at printing from around the world. Specifically focusing on African artist, Xgaoc'o X'are.

In DT, we will be completing a textiles unit looking at joining materials to make our own mini Christmas jumpers.

ICT

In ICT, the children will be looking at online safety and digital painting.

Music

This term your child will be looking at using their voices expressively to create music.

Religious Education

In RE, we will be looking at how God created the world and then we will be exploring the Christmas story.

Physical Education

Whole class PE will be on Tuesday and Friday.
(Dance/Gymnastics) and (Ball skills).

Science

In Science, we will be exploring everyday materials and their properties.

Homework

Homework will be set online. A Topic Grid for the term will be uploaded onto Seesaw as well as weekly spellings for your child to learn. Spelling tests will take place on a **Wednesday**. Maths and English homework will be set every two weeks on MyMaths and on SeeSaw. It is important that all children login to their accounts and complete all homework which is set.
